Please follow the instructions below to share your own research with the Fox School Research Paper Series.

Step 1: Create an account



If you do not already have an account, create one at <http://hq.ssrn.com>. A valid Temple email address and password are required. Please be sure to include your department.

If you already have an account, make sure your contact information and affiliation are up-to-date.

Step 2: Upload your paper



Email your paper as a PDF attachment to foxpaper@temple.edu. Please refer to the submission guidelines below for information on how to format your submission. The Office of Research will upload it to your SSRN profile and include in the appropriate research topic of our Fox Research Paper Series.

SSRN will review and process the submission. Typically, it takes 24-48 hours for papers to become available to the public. You will receive a confirmation email when processing is complete.

Information Required for Submission

1. Full-text paper in PDF format
2. Include the title, author(s) (names and email addresses), abstract, and date when the paper was written or last reviewed
3. If your paper is part of an institutional working paper series, include the name of the series and the working paper number
4. If the paper has already been published or accepted for publication, include the publication information for the reference section
5. Permission from copyright holder (if not yourself) to post on SSRN
